It is understood that no distributions shall be used to discharge or satisfy a legally enforceable obligation of any person, including the Donor(s) or Advisor(s). **Under no circumstances may a distribution from this Fund be used to reimburse or support a donor to the fund.**

Donor Privacy: The Foundation shall <u>not</u> disclose to the public any gift details or any personal donor information. From time-to-time, the Foundation may include the name of the Fund among a list of similar funds in a newsletter or annual report. Charities receiving grants from the Fund may be notified the name of the Fund in the letter accompanying the grant check.

Investment: The Board of Directors of the Foundation shall have full authority and discretion as to the investment and reinvestment of the assets of the Fund.

Management and Control: It is understood and agreed that the Fund therein shall be administered and controlled by the Foundation, subject to its Articles of Incorporation, Schedule of Fees (attached hereto), and By-Laws, as amended from time to time, including the *variance power* contained therein for the Board of Directors of the Foundation to modify any restrictions or conditions if in their sole judgment such restriction becomes, in effect, unnecessary or inconsistent with the charitable needs of the area served by the Foundation.

The Fund shall be the property of the Foundation and shall not be deemed a separate trust fund held by it in a trustee capacity. The Foundation shall have the ultimate authority and control over all property in the Fund, and the income derived there from, for the charitable purposes of the Foundation.
