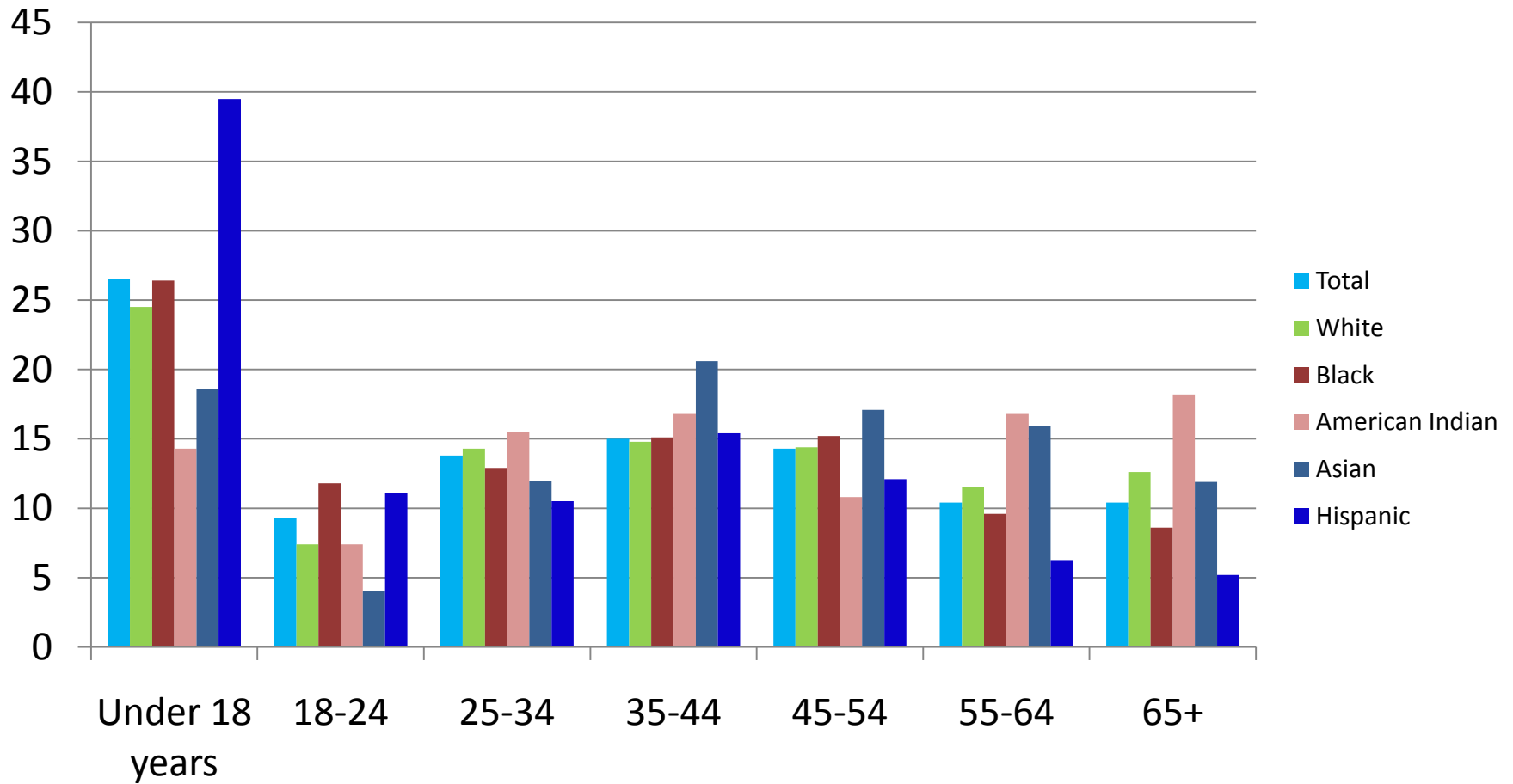

# % Female Racial & Age Composition- Cumberland

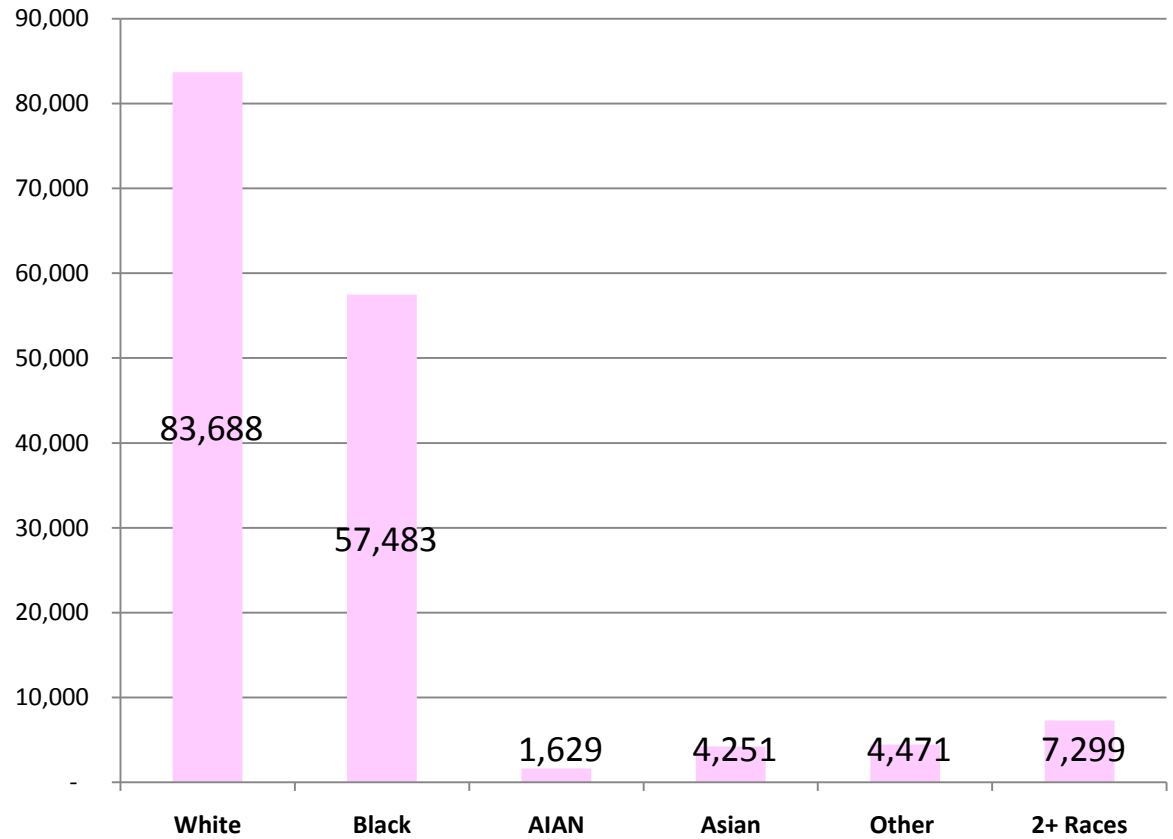

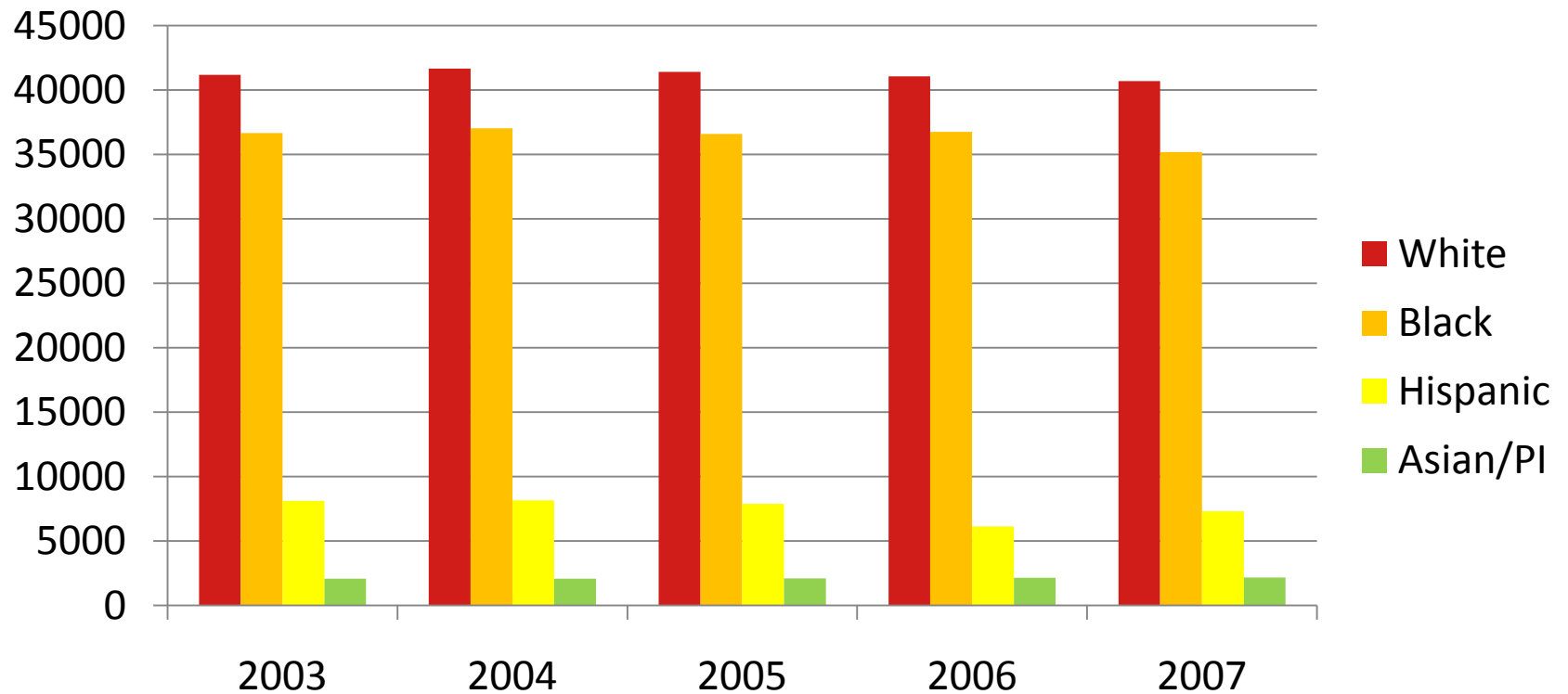

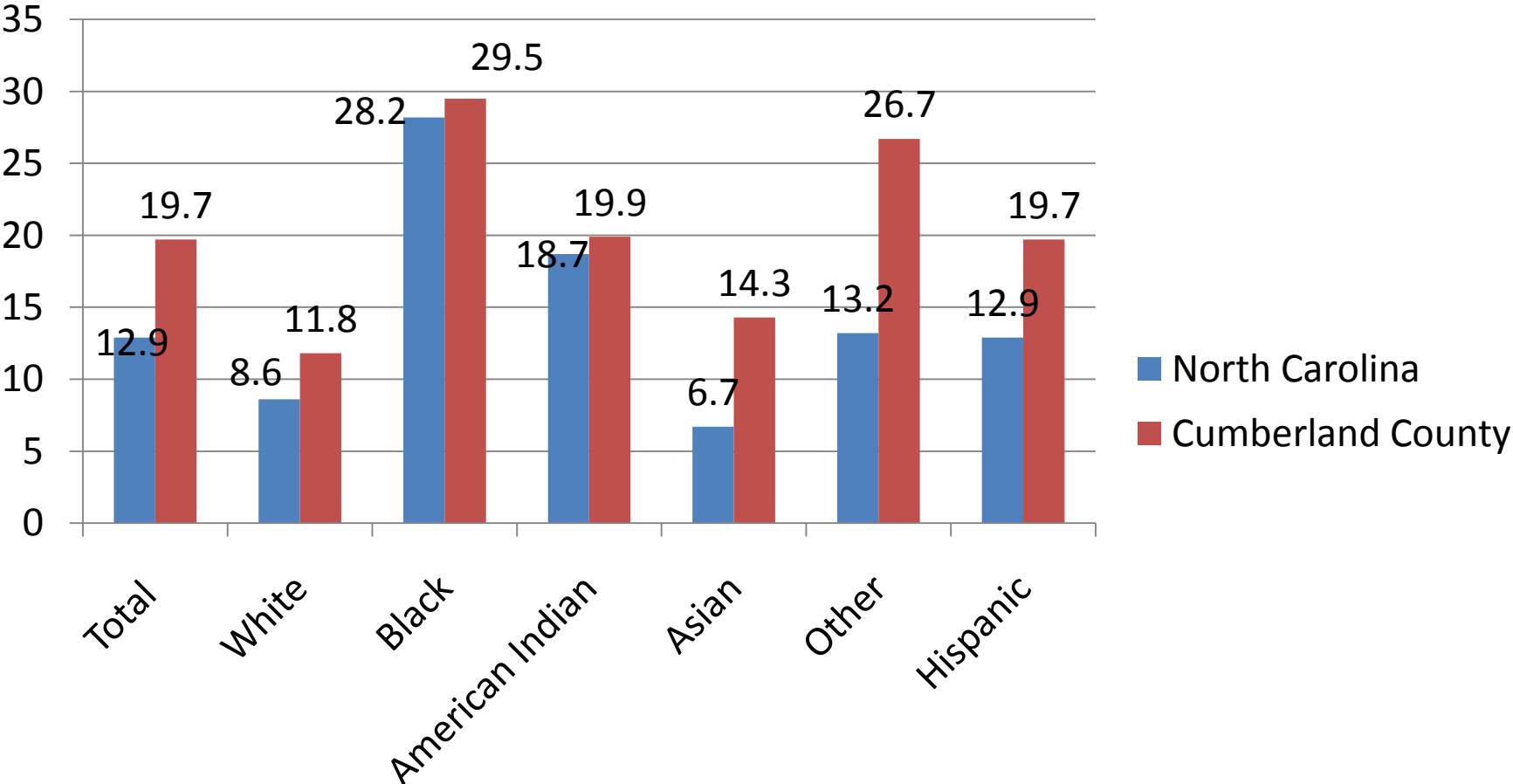

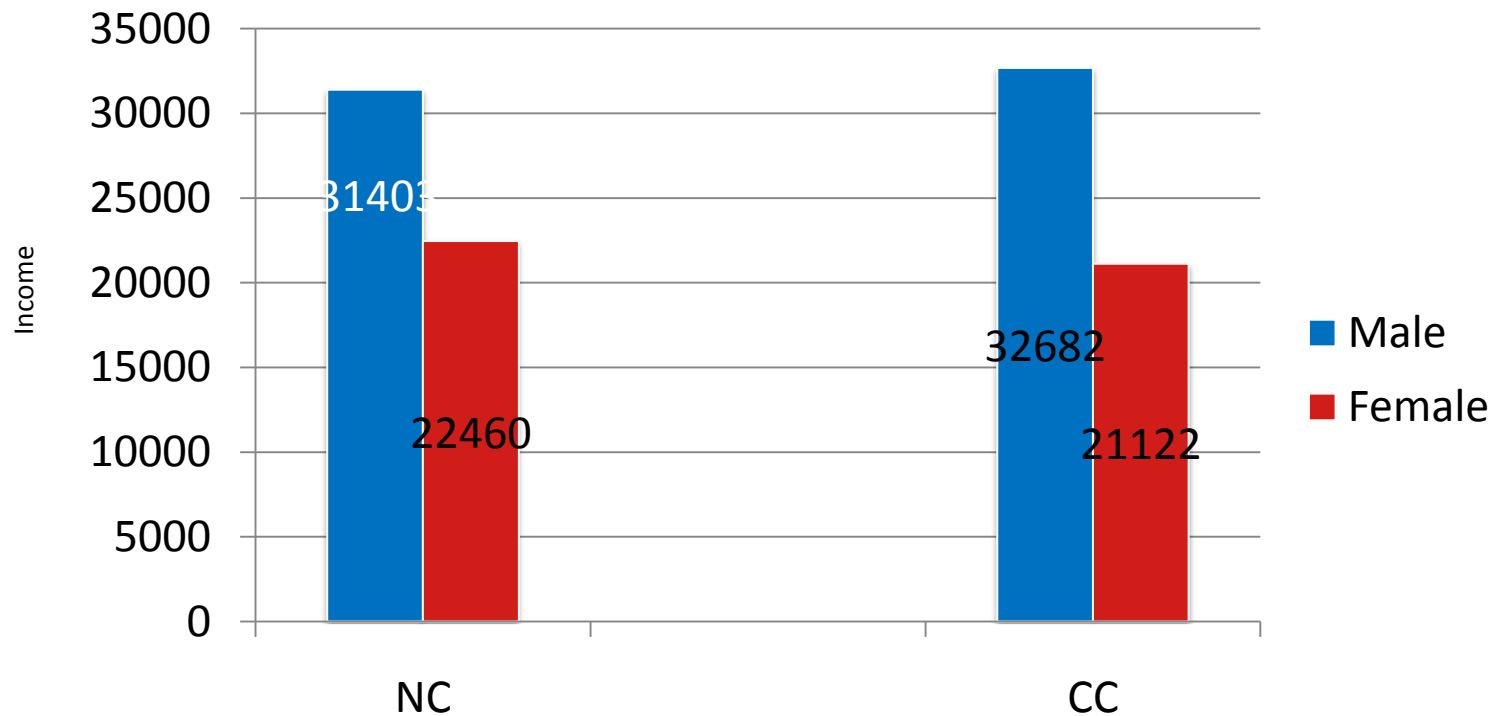

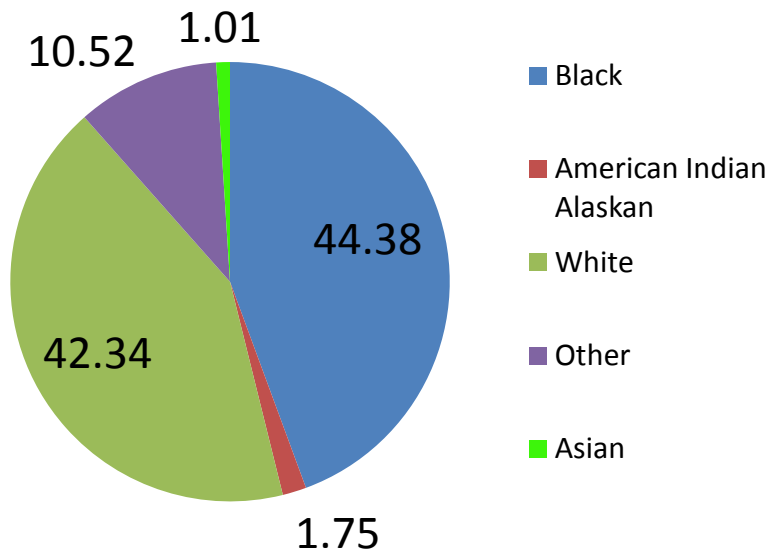

# Racial Composition of Individuals on Food and Nutrition Services

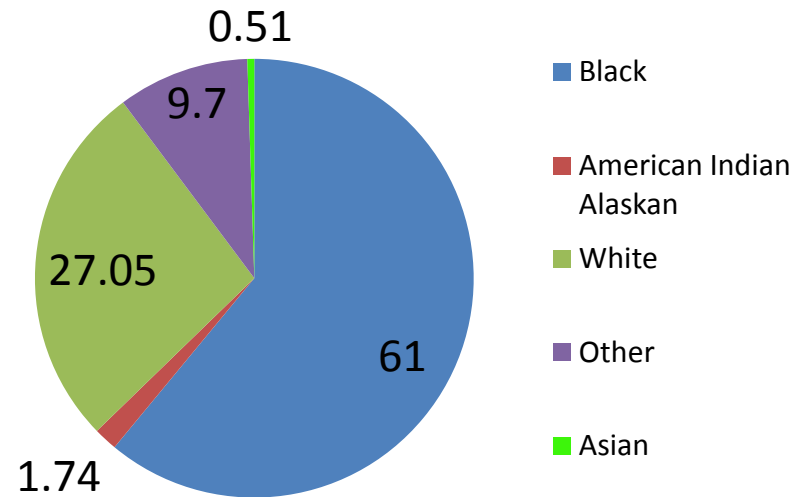

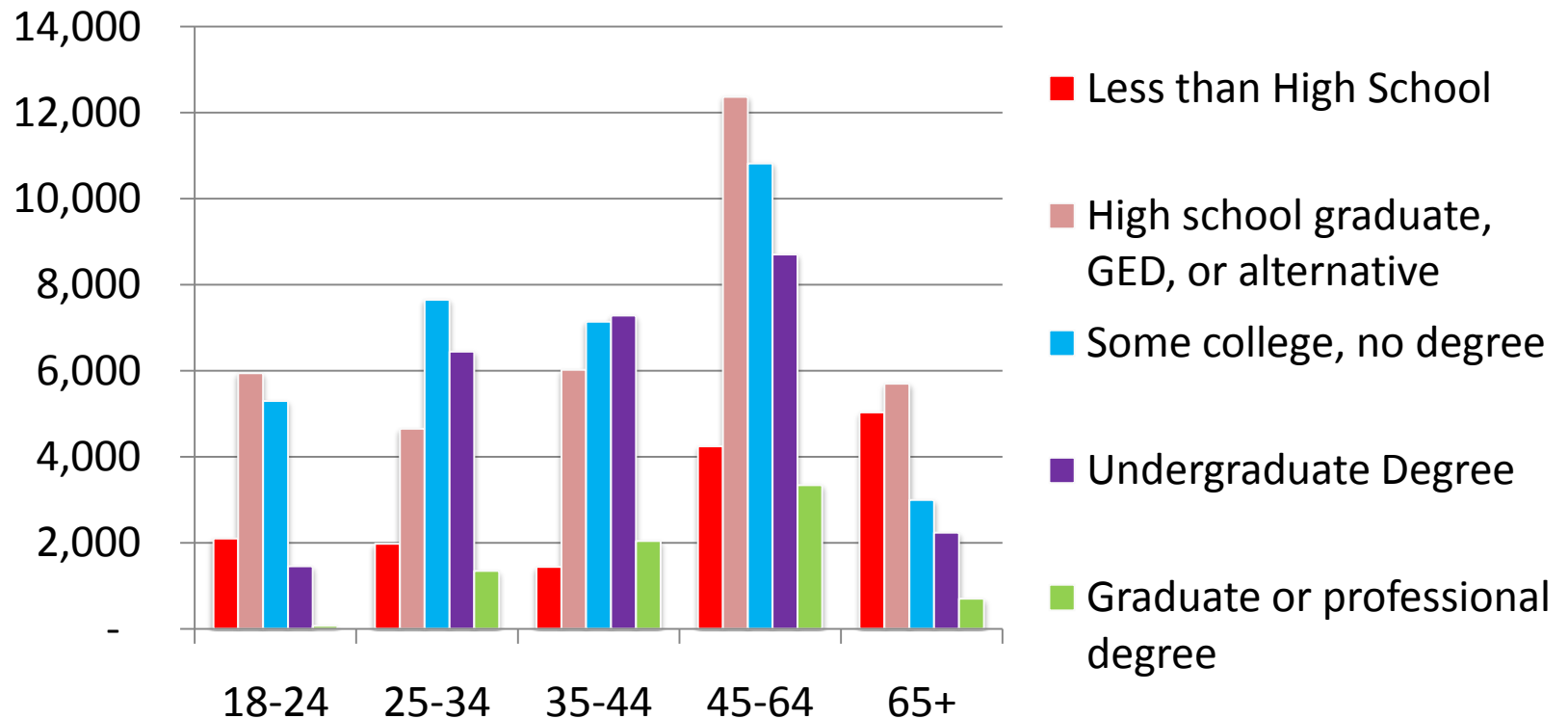

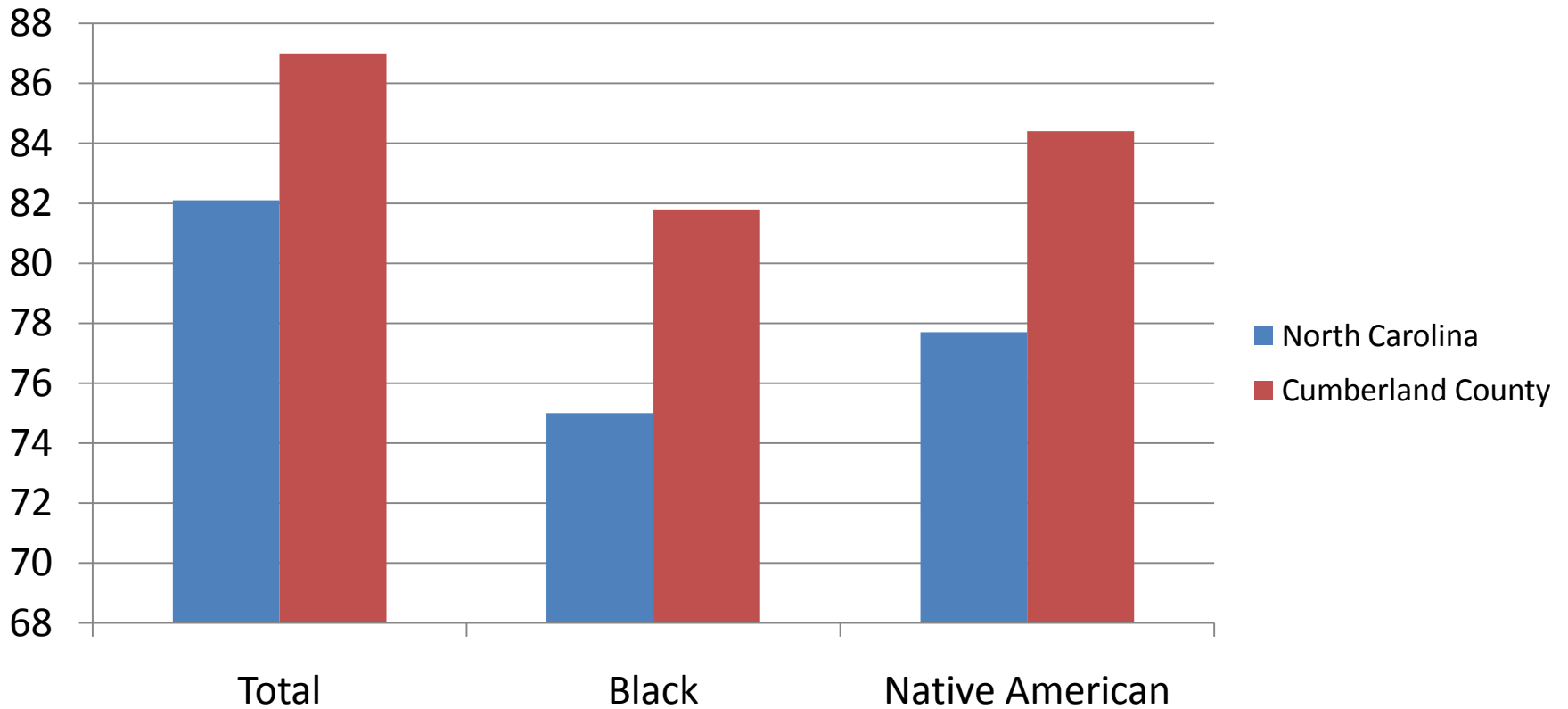


# Level of education for females- Cumberland

## Female Educational Attainment by Age Group

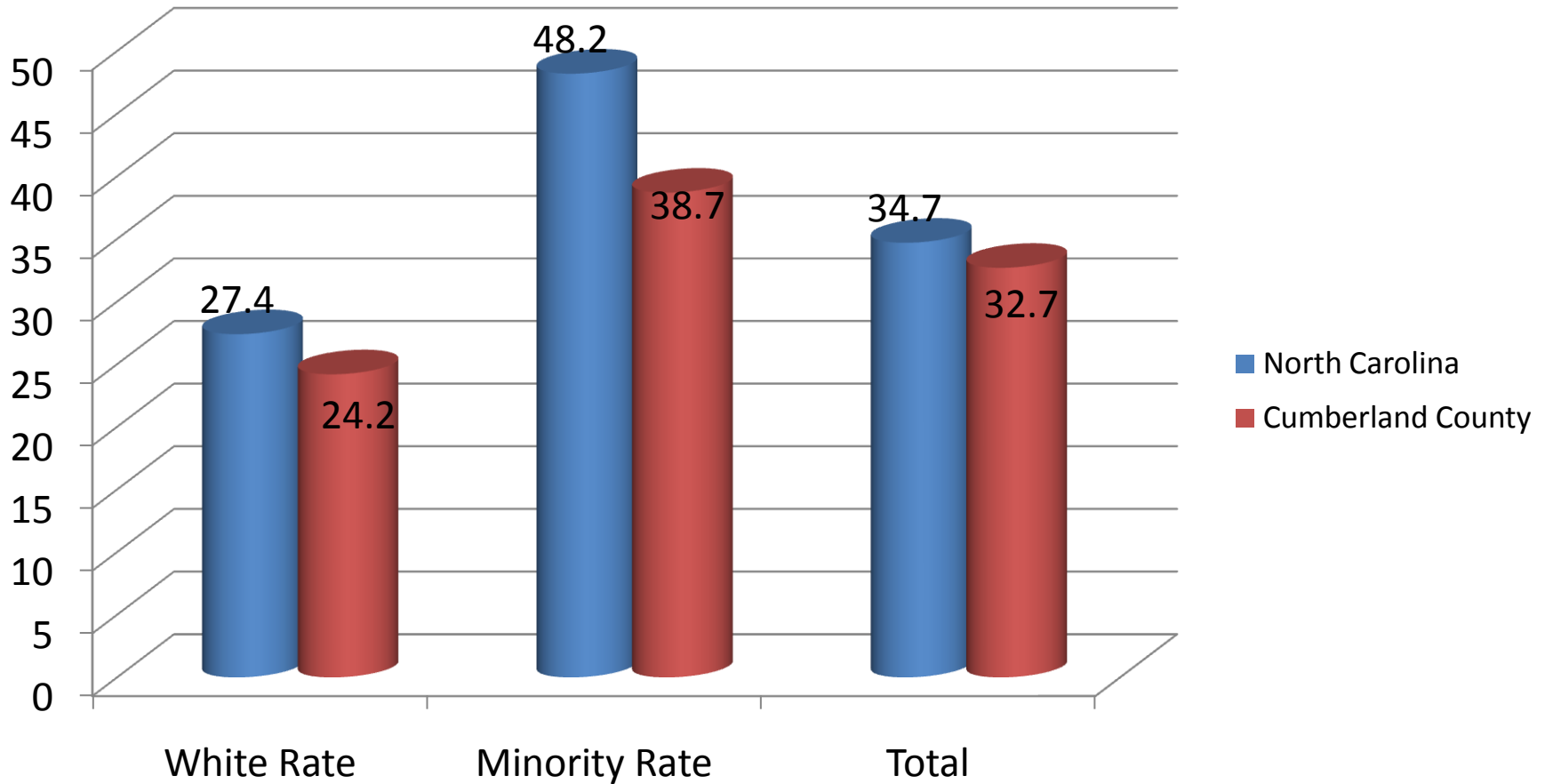


## % Women receiving prenatal care in 1<sup>st</sup> trimester 2004-2008

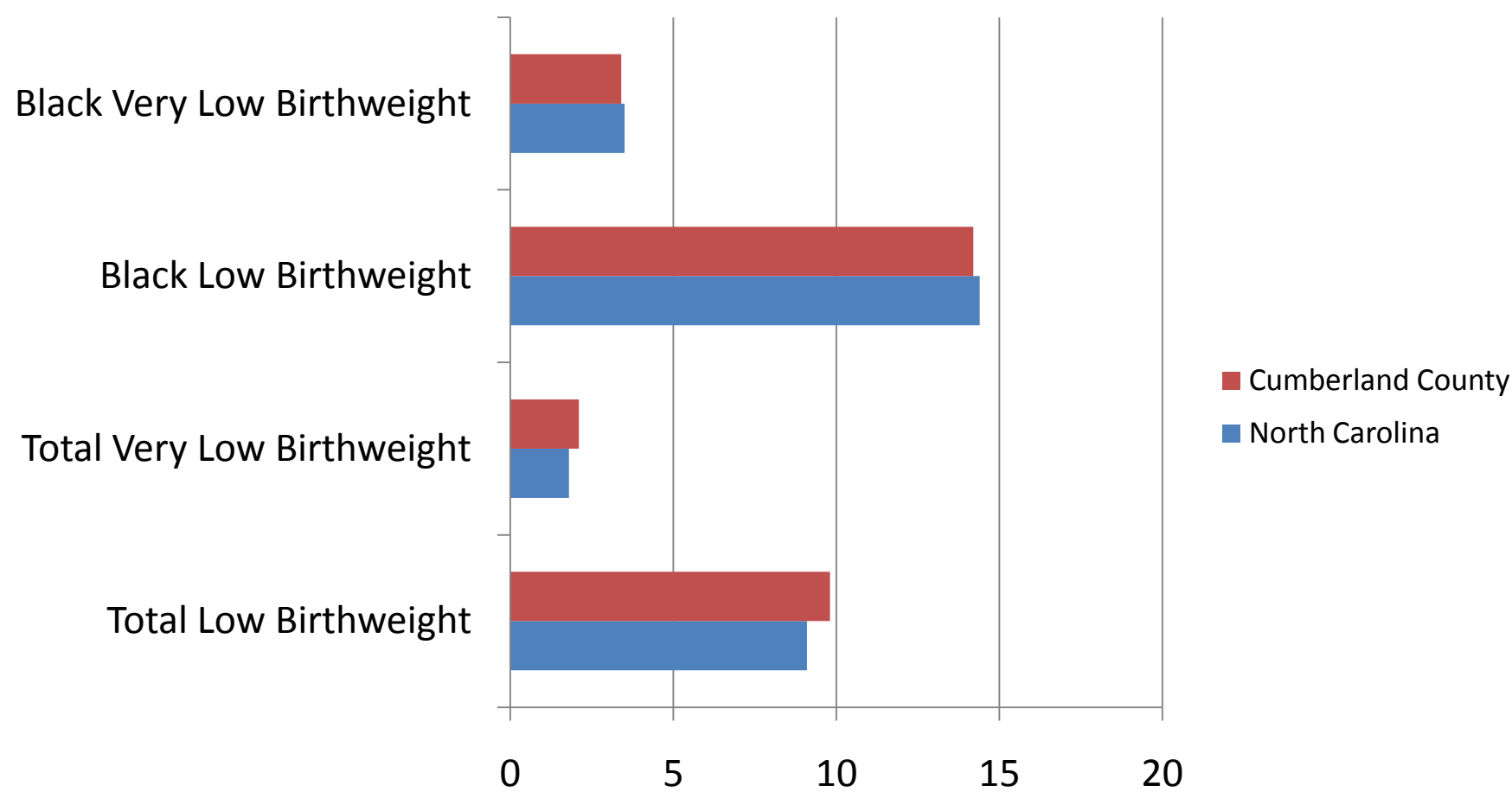

# Pregnancy Rates girls 15-17 years 2004-2008

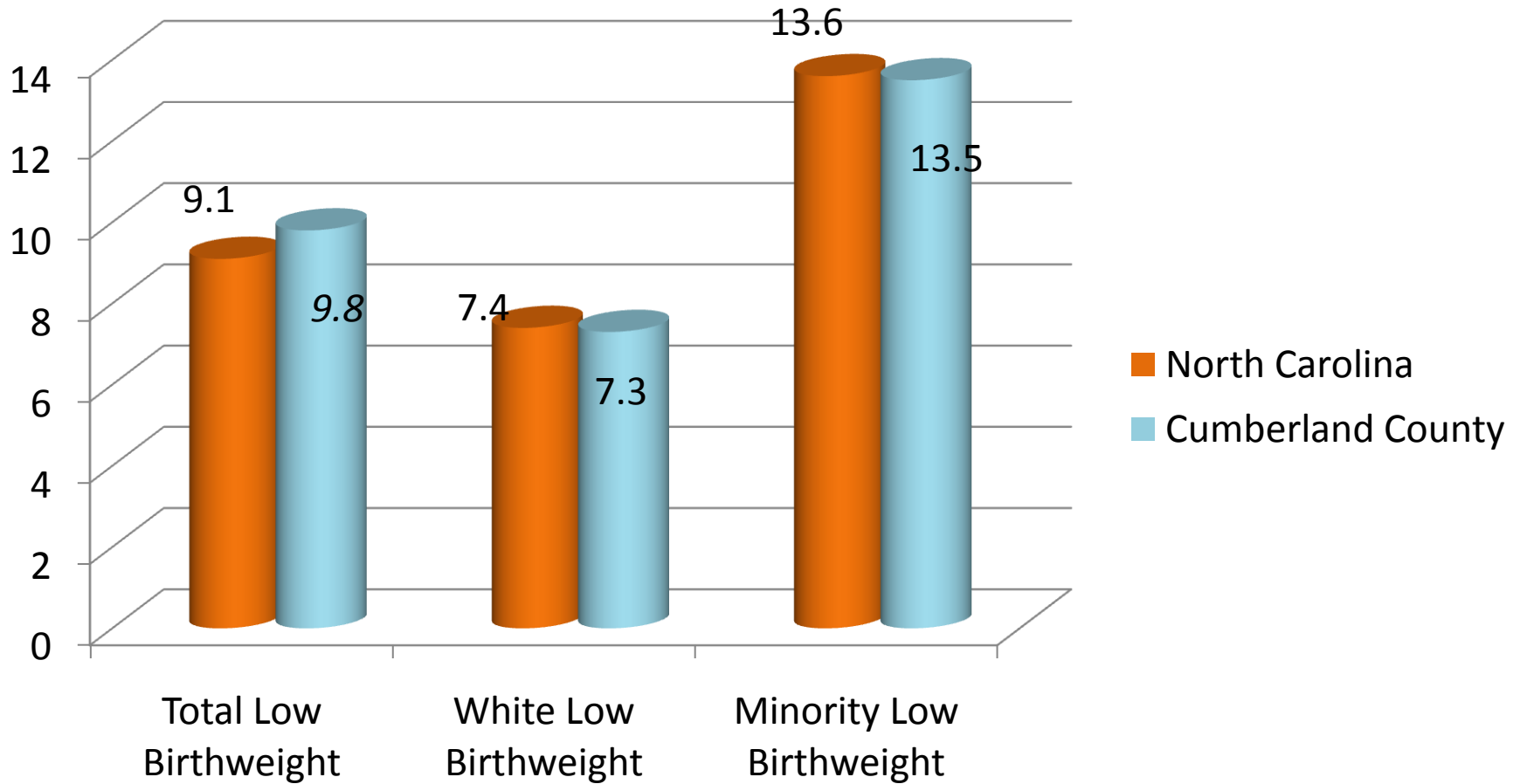


# Low ( $\leq 2500$ gms) and Very Low ( $\leq 1500$ gms) Birth weights



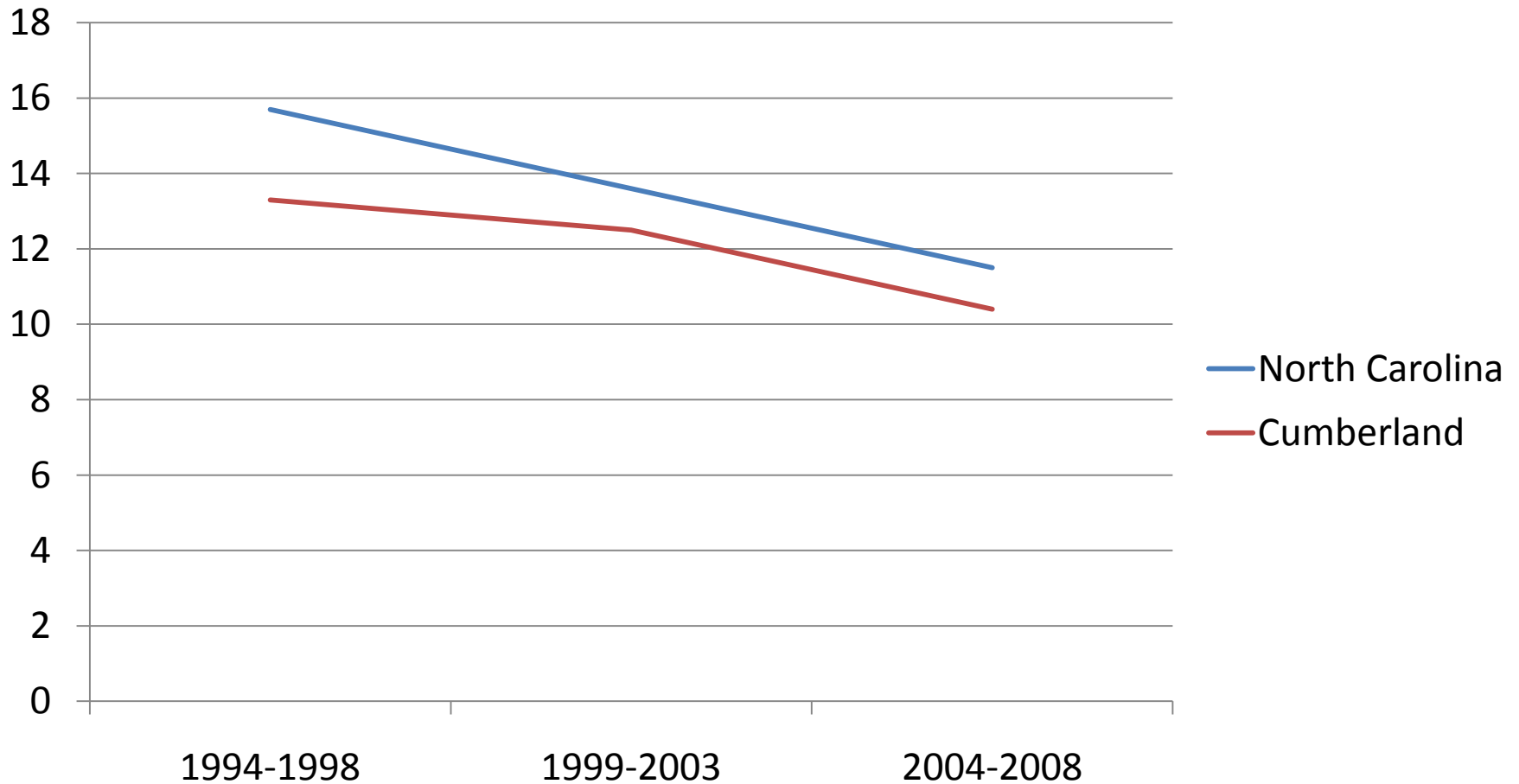

# % Low birth weight infants by race 2004-2008



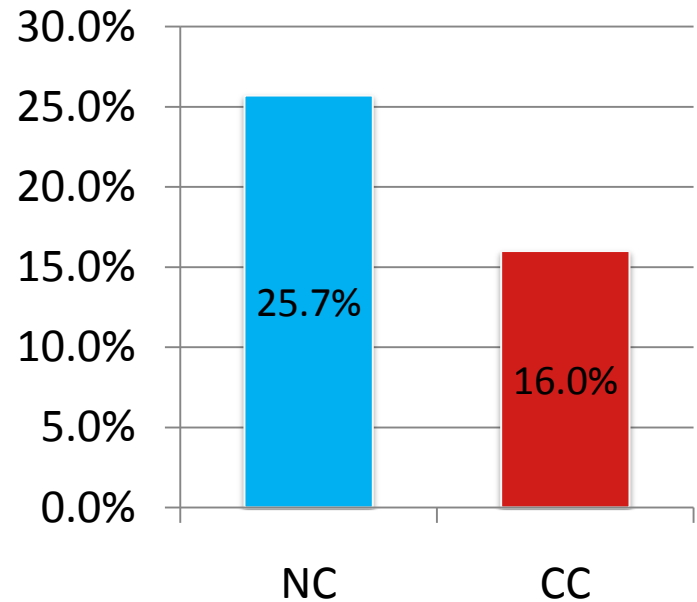
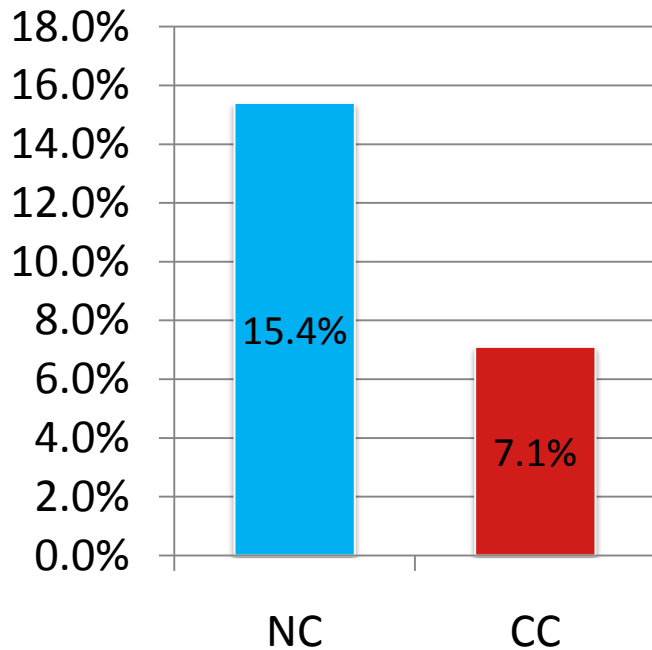


# Percentage of Live Births where mother smoked during pregnancy-Trend data



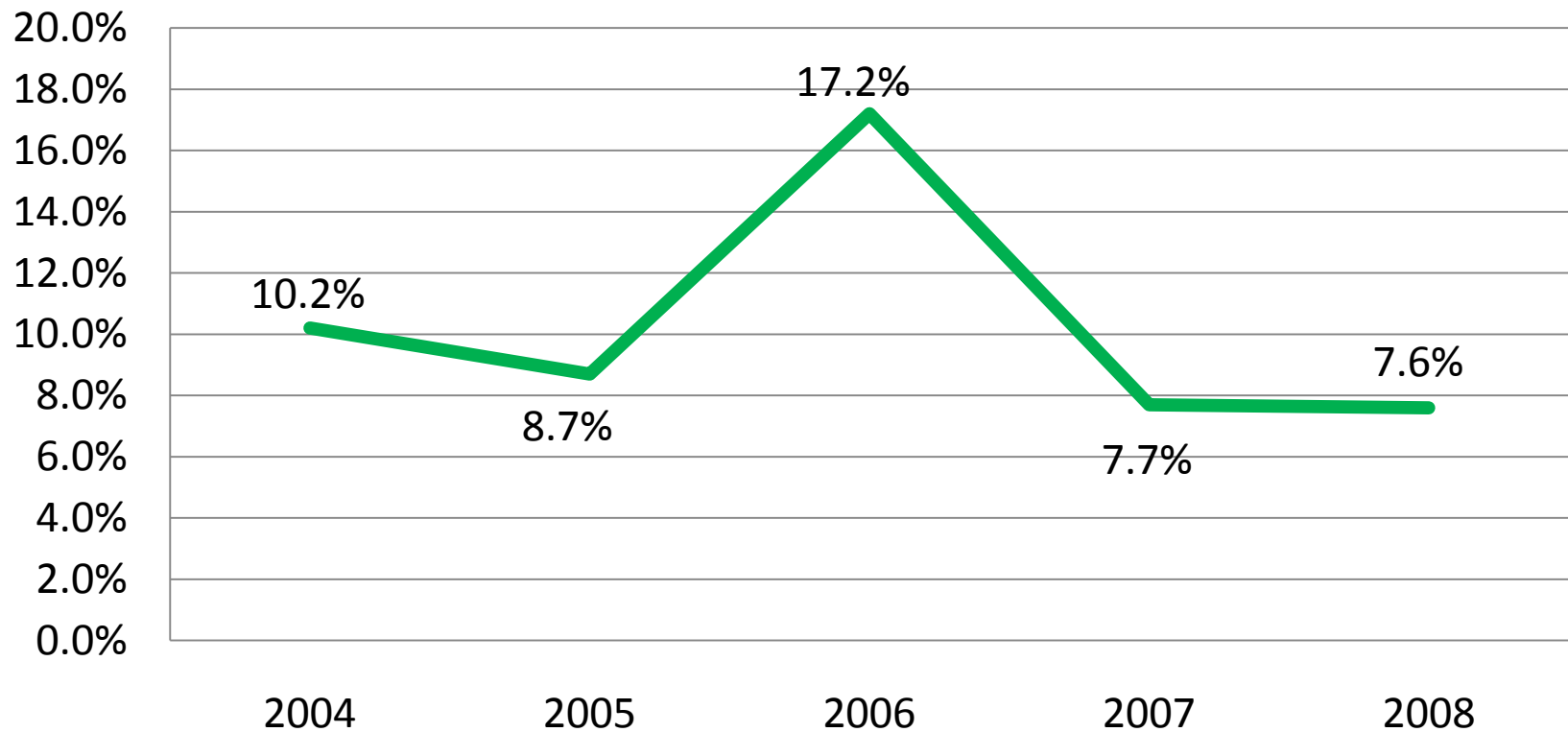
# Prevalence of Obesity in Children-2008

- Obese Children ages 5-11

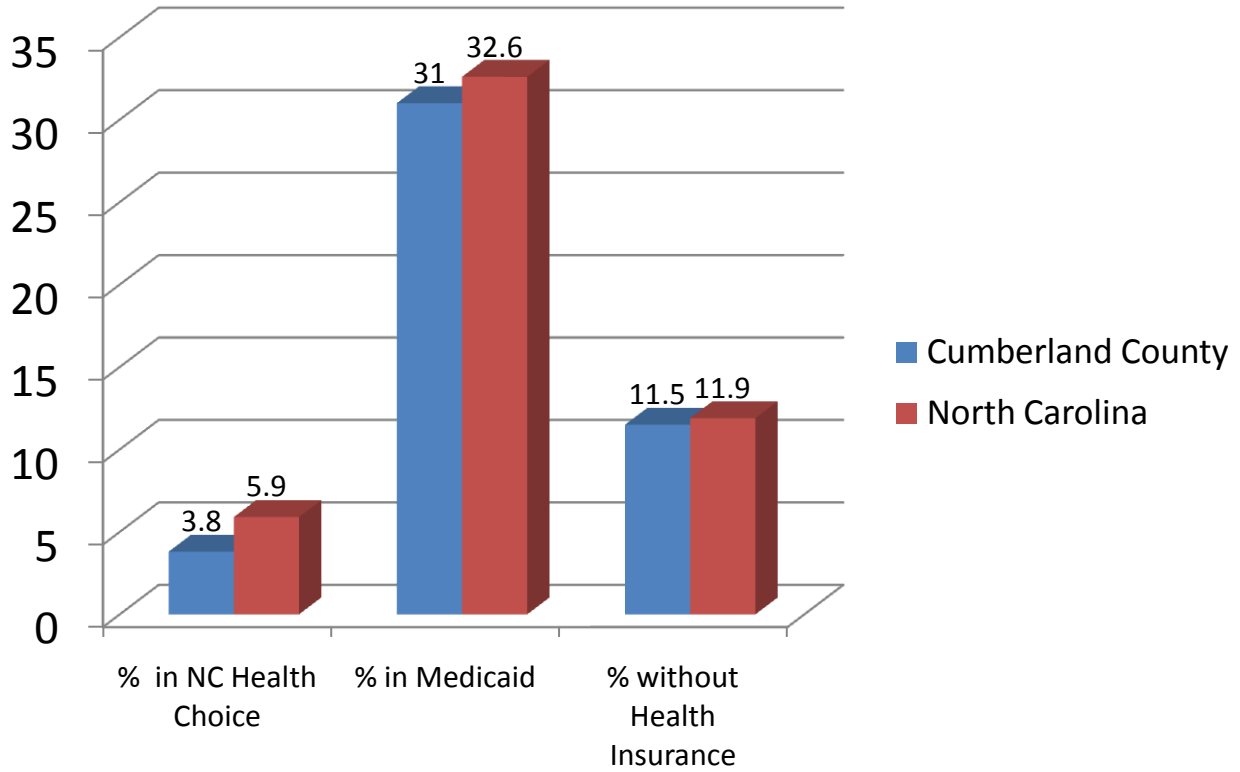


# Low Income Childhood Obesity- Cumberland

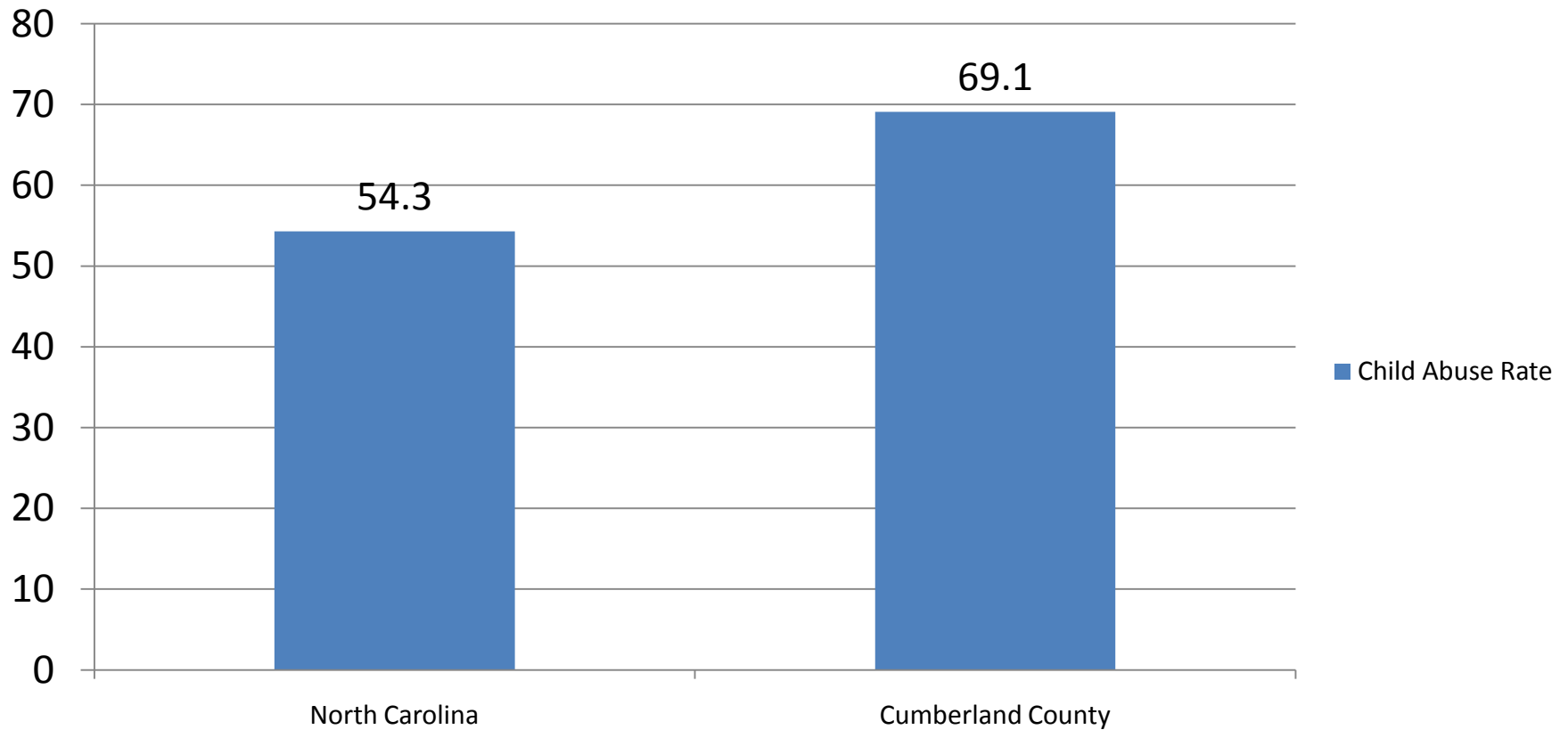

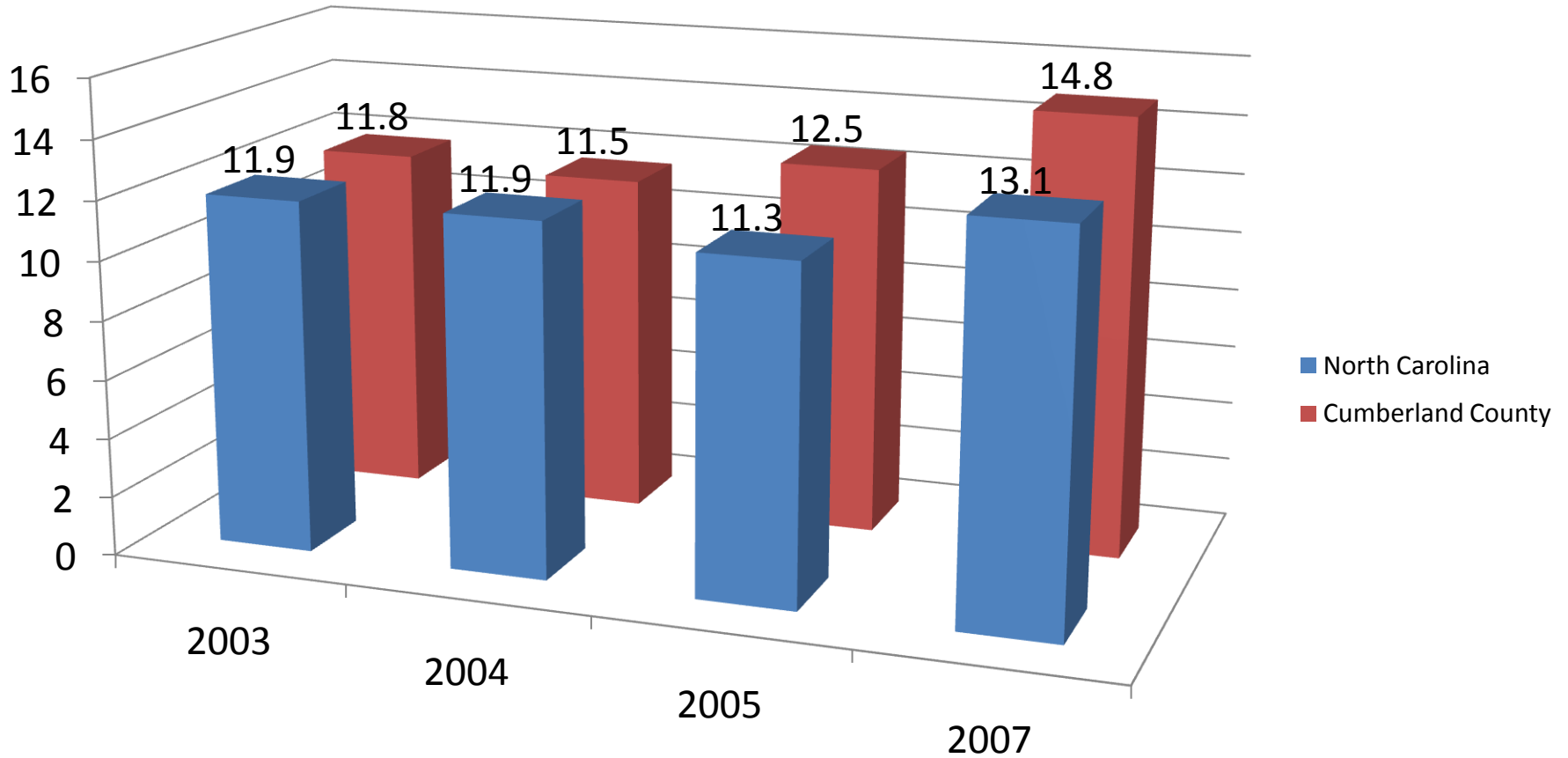

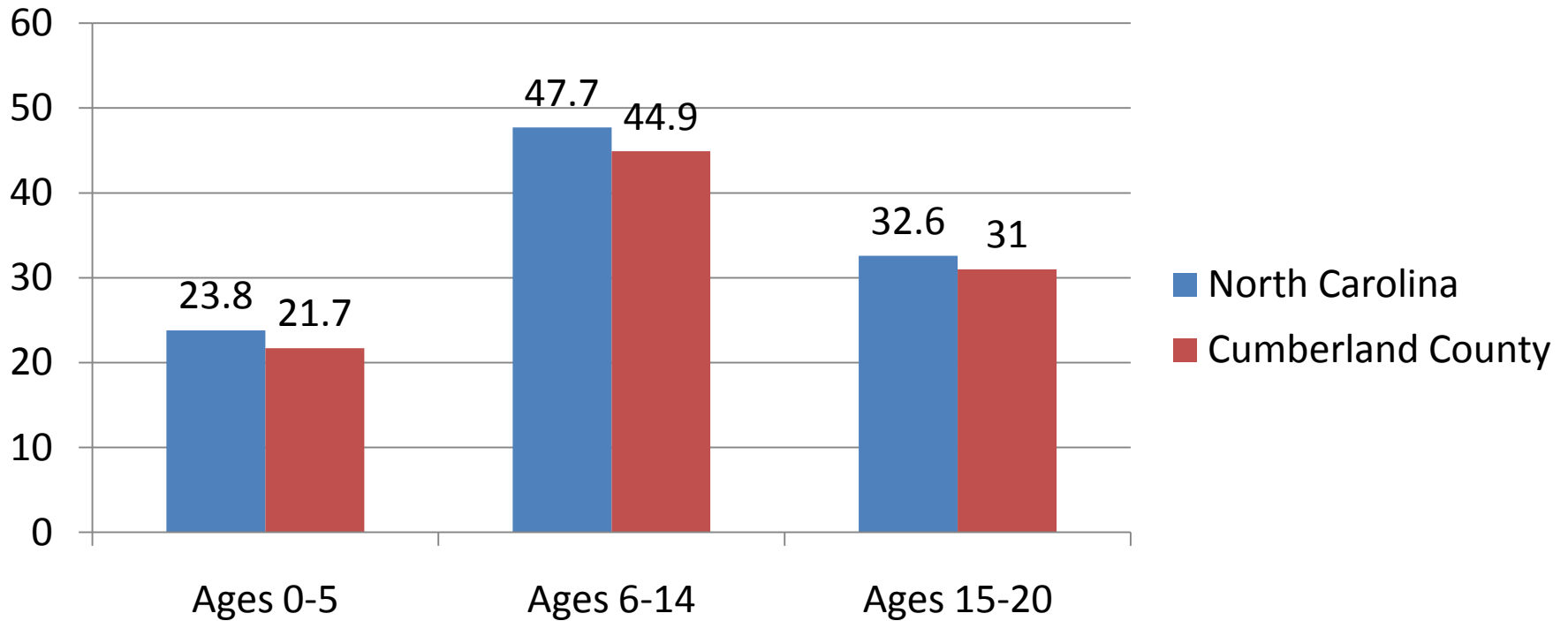

# % Uninsured Children NC & CC- Trends Data



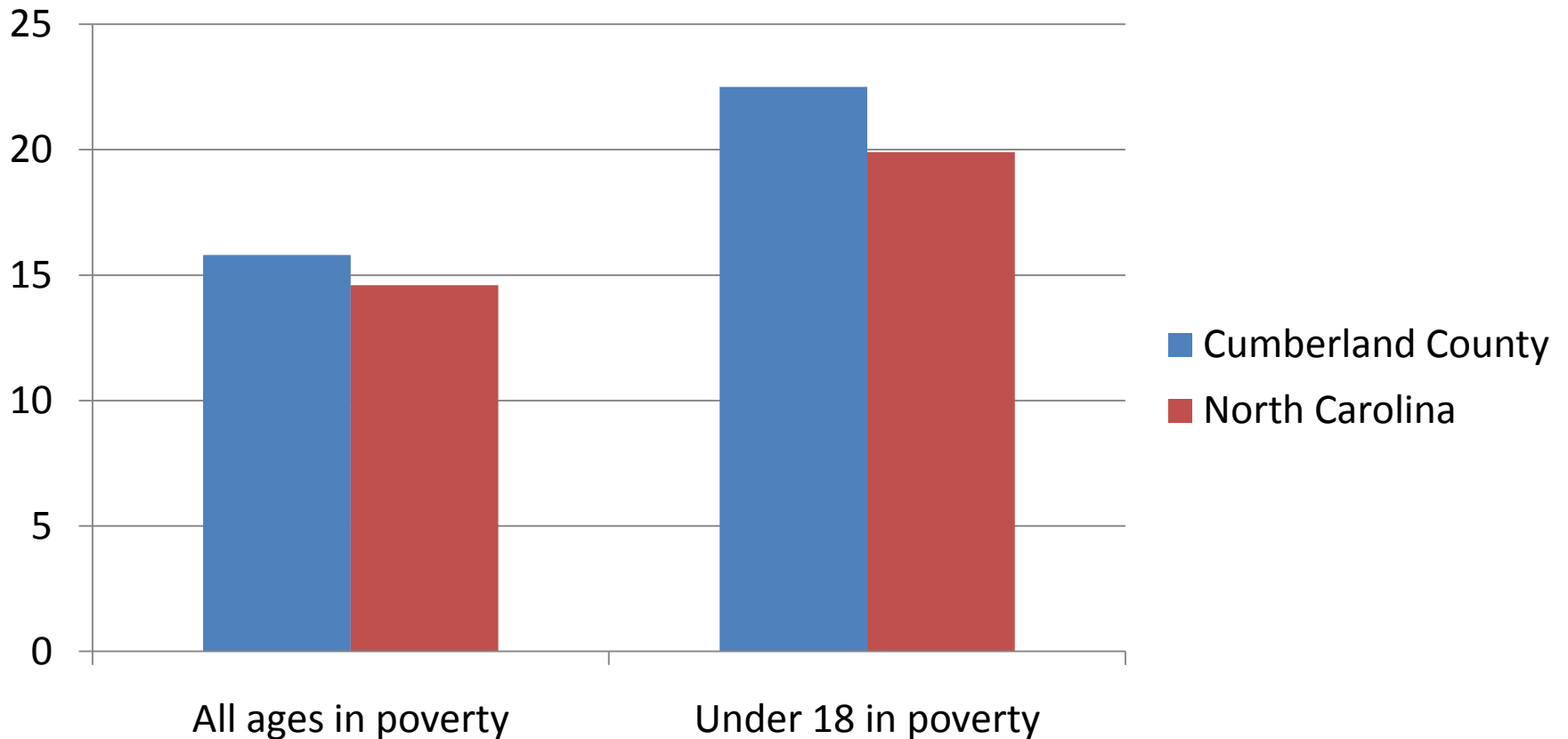
# % Title XIX eligible children receiving dental services- 2006
